

Bencubbin Station Masters

Bencubbin Railway Station is 192 rail miles north east of Perth. Terminus of the Wyalkatchem – Bencubbin railway, opened 1 February 1917 and extended to Kalkalling (later Lake Brown) on 15 October 1923.

Station manned from 1 October 1923 – 1 October 1981.
